Phase 1

DOCUMENTATION

3 weeks April 1st - 20th

- Curriculum Vitae (CV) (updated).
- Recommendation letter (from any mentor or leader who has seen you in action).
- Proof of English proficiency (minimum B2) certificates, documents, essays, or reports demonstrating language proficiency.
- Motivation Letter (express your motivation for joining the program, maximum 1 page).
- Bonus Document (free format we want to get to know you better).

Phase 2

ICIMS INTERVIEW

1 week April 22nd - 27th

- Asynchronous interview via the iCIMS platform (maximum duration: 1 hour, in English).
- After your interview, you must read the following books:
 - 'Jonathan Livingston Seagull' by Richard Bach.'
 - 'Make Your Bed' by William H. McRaven.'

Phase 3

GROUP SESSION SIMULATION

2 weeks May 20th - 30th

- Schedule your attendance for the group session simulation (approximately 30 minutes).
